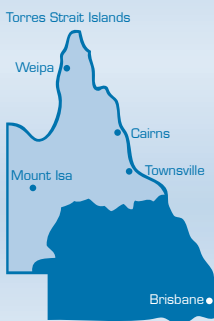

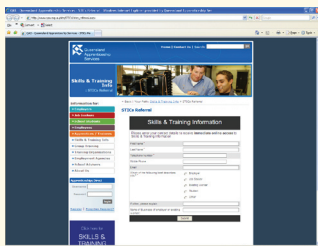
Step 2
